

The Buckhorn Community Centre has invested in a sustainable future, and we invite you to become a contributing donor!

A grid-tied solar panel array has been installed on the south-facing roof of the Buckhorn Community Centre. Three hundred and twelve panels with a 73.3 kW capacity are generating energy that is being sold back to the Ontario power grid. Revenue generated from this solar array will contribute in cost savings, allowing the BCC to provide more services and programs for the Buckhorn Community until 2031.

We are excited and proud to be participating in this clean-energy initiative, but we cannot do it alone. The BCC has embarked on a **Sponsor – A – Panel** fundraising campaign with the hopes of raising \$175,000 – the remaining cost of the mortgage we secured when we installed the panels. The BCC has been self sustaining for many years, but could not have done so without the community's continued donations and support. We would like this project to be a community endeavour, and are hoping we can count on you to assist us.

To commemorate this project and recognize our contributing donors, we have installed a permanent **Solar Legacy** mural display. This beautiful mural is situated on the exterior, south-facing wall of the BCC, directly under the roof-mounted solar array. All our donors are recognized on plaques that are incorporated into the display. When people come to the BCC, they will see our array and recognize all of the community donors who helped to make it possible.

The Solar Array Initiative

Internationally, there is a growing awareness of the need to reduce our reliance on non-renewable, carbon-emitting sources of energy. A transition has begun toward sustainable, cleaner sources of energy, such as harnessing solar energy. Acknowledging this transition, the province of Ontario is taking measures to establish renewable energy industries in Ontario, and has offered incentives to encourage private landowners to be pioneers of renewable energy. The Buckhorn Community Centre, recognizing the importance of using renewable energy to power our community's future, is proud to be a partner in this initiative. By investing in this project, we have supported a budding renewable energy industry in our province, and generating revenue that can be used to provide more social and recreational programs for the Buckhorn community. Furthermore, Buckhorn will be recognized in our area as a leader in environmental stewardship.

Flanagan and Sun, a Buckhorn-based renewable energy company, supplied the solar array equipment at cost. With the help of community volunteers, Flanagan and Sun installed the solar array system for no additional fee. This generous contribution means your donation will go directly to the cost of the mortgage. The 73.3kW system has cost the BCC \$350,000. We have paid off \$175,000 of mortgage since 2011. The "Sponsor – A – Panel" campaign offers individuals and businesses the opportunity to make a donation to assist the BCC with paying off the loan. By sponsoring a solar panel, you are contributing to a clean, renewable energy source, and investing in the community's future.
