Rules of Entry (Please read carefully)

- 1. Each artist may submit two pieces for the competition. It must have been completed within the past 12 months.
- 2. The piece of art must have the artist's name, phone, city of residence, medium and title of artwork on the back or on an index card attached to the back of the artwork.
- 3. The artwork must be original in concept, design, and execution.
- 4. The Entry Form must be completed and attached with \$5.00 fee for each piece (max 2)

5. Any artist who previously exhibited in the BFOA within the last 5yrs cannot enter the AA Framed Artwork and gallery wrapped canvas must be ready for hanging complete with

wire AND MUST NOT EXCEED A PERIMETER OF 120" INCLUDING FRAME.

Artworks must be wired and ready to hang (D rings are acceptable provided they are a minimum of $\frac{1}{2}$ inch in diameter).

Wire should be placed 1/3 down from the top of the frame or artwork piece.

Wire should be appropriate for weight of the artwork. Large artwork should be wired with triple strand wire.

Please wrap sharp edges of wiring with tape.

Fibre Art / Textiles should be submitted with proper display equipment. It can be hung with a pocket / sleeve sewn to the top back with a rod or dowel to extend one inch either side of the artwork.

All submitted 3-D artwork must not exceed 50 pounds.

7. Advertising, and commercial art installations are not eligible.

8. Competition Organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason, and will, if the above prerequisites are not met. 9. The decisions of the judges are final.

10. Entries can be picked up at the conclusion of the Festival on Sunday August 17, between 3 & 4 pm. No exceptions or early pick-up. Be sure to retain your original receipt: You must present it in order to reclaim your artwork-No matter who is picking up..
