

**Buckhorn Spring &
Harvest Craft Show
Held annually
Victoria Day (Saturday & Sunday) and Thanksgiving weekend
(Saturday – Monday)**

We do not have a formal application form. We request that you send 3-5 photographs or slides and a brief resume by the end of February for the Spring show and by the end of July - for the Harvest Show. Please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope, if you wish the return of the photos. **Mail to: Buckhorn Craft Shows, Box 79, Buckhorn, Ontario, K0L-1J0.** **Pictures can be sent by E-mail to the address below. They should be in JPEG Format and no larger than 800 x 600. Email to the Director Diane Michell: michelldiane@gmail.com No deposit is required at this time.**

Our Selection Committee will meet within 1 week of the above closing dates and will make their decisions. Contracts that are awarded will then be sent out as quickly as possible and the booth rental fee will then be due with the return of the contract.

A 10' Booth is \$70.00 (HST Inc.) Plus 10% Commission on all sales. We also have 12' and 16' booths at slightly higher rates. An extra fee is charged for table rental. (There is a minimum \$100 fee expected at the end of a show). All booths are undercover, all our walls wood.

Therefore you can nail or screw into them. (No tents allowed.)

Booths are set up inside the main building and we also have 11 pavillions behind the main building. These buildings have 8 foot wide doors at each end that usually stay open during the show. Buildings have heaters but depending on the way the wind blows, it can get cool so dress for weather. All booths are on cement floors, a rug or padding underneath your feet would help. Our electric system does not support everyone bringing a micro heater. If you have a little propane heater, by all means bring that.

Placement of exhibitors is at the discretion of the Director.

Attendance at the Spring Show can be up to 2,000 and at the Harvest Show 3,000+

Restrictions: Limited jewellery permitted. Each jewellery exhibitor will be individually considered. Pets are not permitted at the show.
